



The Carpenedolo **Info Point & Shop**, a new service for residents dedicated to waste, recycling and environmental good practice, is opening in Piazza Europa, in the Town Hall.

Here you can collect **bags and containers** for door-to-door separate waste collection free of charge, request **wheelie bins** for non-domestic users and joint domestic users, request a **composter** or collection of **bulky items**, start collection of **nappies and pads** and report any waste management **service issues**.

Eco-friendly products for the whole family are also on sale: eco-friendly detergents and natural cosmetics, biodegradable detergents, games and accessories for children.

Waste disposal centre

The waste disposal centre is a **secure area** for disposing of bulky waste (furniture, armchairs, sofas, etc.) WEEE - Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (small and large domestic appliances) - food oils, car batteries, T and/ or F containers, used batteries, paint, inert materials, wood, metal and every other type of waste not collected door to door.

A leap forward in quality

From 1 August 2015, the **door-to-door collection** of household waste in Carpenedolo will be expanded and extended to the whole town. **Paper, plastic, organic, glass, tins and non-recyclable waste** will be collected door to door. Green Service stations for the collection of domestic green waste will also be installed and new home collection services on request will be introduced, such as for bulky waste for the over 65s and nappies and pads for families who require it. This system will permit a greater quantity of recyclable material to be recovered and the level of non-recyclable waste to be disposed of in the landfill to be reduced to a minimum.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

The street bins vanish and all waste is collected door to door. In July, each family must collect, free of charge, the kit **with the new bags and bins for door-to-door collection**, together with useful, detailed information (the guide to services, eco-calendar and "Where shall I throw it?").

Free kit for domestic users

(to be collected in July at the Palestra Dante, presenting personal Carta Regionale dei Servizi [health service card])

It contains:

- ✓ 2 brown bins for organic waste collection
- ✓ 1 green bin for glass and tin collection
- ✓ Yellow bags for plastic packaging
- ✓ Blue bags for remaining dry non-recyclable waste
- ✓ Mater-bi bags for organic waste collection
- ✓ Information

Non-domestic users (companies, shops) and **joint domestic users** can request the bins that meet their requirements directly, by contacting the **Info Point** (tel. 030 902605).

Put out the bags and bins from **10 pm** the day before collection and by **6 am** on the day of collection.

Less waste with composting

Home composting is a **natural process** that allows organic kitchen and garden waste to be transformed into **excellent compost**, to be used for gardening and growing vegetables.



To compost at home, all you need is to have a garden and use a composter, composting box, heap or pit

Residents who are interested in this environmentally friendly practice can request a **compost bin on a free-loan basis**, by contacting the **Info Point** (tel. 030 902605).

Green Service

For the collection of **domestic green waste**, 6 stations with bins for disposing of waste from pruning, grass, leaves, etc. will be installed in the area.



Nappies and pads

To support the families who require it, a twice-weekly nappy and pad collection service is also available. Special bags will be provided. For information, contact the **Info Point** (tel. 030 902605).
